The **Systems Project option** explores immersive and spatial audio across studio, film and live production contexts. Through hands-on, project-based learning, you'll develop skills in immersive audio workflows and techniques while engaging with industry trends, accessibility and evolving production systems.

You'll create a high-end immersive audio project and graduate with a finished production and a cohesive body of work demonstrating your creative and technical capability.

The **Studio Design project option** explores contemporary studio practice where you'll develop expertise in electroacoustics, acoustic treatment, room correction and digital audio routing, with a focus on spatial and immersive sound.

You'll undertake projects such as designing or retrofitting Dolby Atmos mixing rooms, developing critical listening spaces, or improving acoustic performance in unconventional environments.
